Improves learning

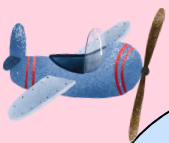
Talking and playing with others help kids learn new words and ideas.

Krishna and Sudama were best friends from childhood, studying together.



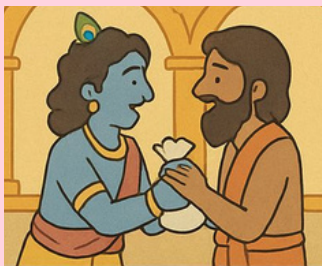
After School, Krishna became a king and Sudama lived a simple life.

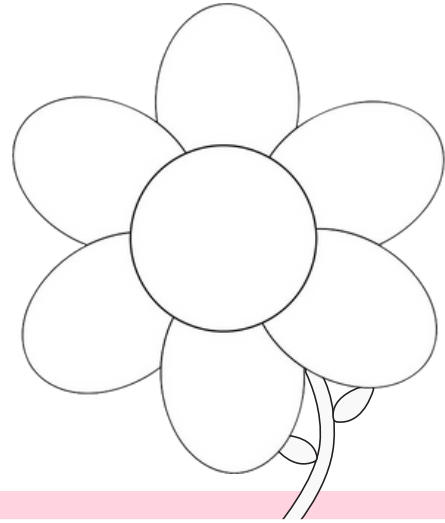
